# DIGITAL RADIO EUROPE AND ASIA PACIFIC (at year end 2013)



- 4. Digital radio listening (reach and share)


#### DAB/DAB+ RECEIVER SALES (INCLUDING LINE FIT AUTOMOTIVE)


### **DAB/DAB+ HOUSEHOLD PENETRATION YEARS 2011 - 2013**

the % of people who listen to digital radio in a given time period


