What is Service Following?

Link together transmissions of the **same** or **similar** programmes so that a listener does not have to manually retune when moving between coverage areas.

Synonymous with existing functionality in FM using PI code alignment and AF (Alternative Frequencies).

Implementation of Service Following is important so that listeners do not experience a **regression** of experience when moving to DAB from FM





Examples of Service Following


Norway - Regional NRK ensembles

7 regional ensembles with different frequencies

 Each region has one or more regionalized versions of the service NRK P1

Each region has its own Traffic station


All other stations are similar in all regions






Implicit linking

- National services have the same Service Id in all regions.
- Before FM switch-off all DAB Service IDs were aligned with RDS PI codes.





Hard linking linkage set





Regionale PI-Codes und Service-IDs






