New DAB/DMB Remote Monitoring Product Demonstrated at IBC 2007 First showing of the DABSTOR DAB/DMB Publisher/Subscriber at IBC 2007 (Stand Number 8.489)

At IBC 2007, SomerData (Wells, UK) will be demonstrating the latest enhancements to its **DABSTOR** product range, including the all-new DAB/DMB remote service monitoring capability.

The new **DABSTOR** *Publisher* option enables remotely located control centres to simultaneously render all Audio, Video and Data services, via a network connection, using the new *Subscriber* application. The *Subscriber* application also supports services from external sources, so that, for example, an audio, video or data service can be rendered simultaneously from the multiplexer input, the multiplexer output and from a compatible DAB/DMB receiver.


SomerData's **DABSTOR** product range is widely used by DAB\DMB broadcasters and network service providers for monitoring ensemble data integrity and content as well as continuous logging of the multiplexer output. Other uses include; testing, development and troubleshooting of hardware and services.

DABSTOR handles real-time input streams as well as ETI data files that have been previously recorded. Quality and content are simultaneously monitored for all Audio, Data, MOT and DMB services, which can also be extracted and saved to disk for further analysis and playback. The latest release (demonstrated at IBC 2007) supports T-DMB and DAB-IP video services, international character sets, Electronic Programme Guide (EPG), external alarms and SNMP reporting.

For other testing, simulation and monitoring requirements, **DABSTOR** is available in transportable and rack-mount configurations, with a choice of Recorder, Replayer and Monitor applications.

Other new products on display at IBC 2007 include an updated version of **DABAIR**, its DAB/DMB Service Monitoring Receiver, which includes support for the new DAB⁺ audio format, plus the new **DRSS** 1:8 Digital Splitter for ETI streams.
