DMB/DAB+ on Air During Radio Days Europe

Spanish network provider Abertis Telecom and Dutch infrastructure specialist Broadcast Partners have partnered with WorldDMB and International DMB Advancement Group (IDAG) to provide live mobile TV and digital radio during Radio Days Europe 2012 in Barcelona, one of the the world's biggest radio conferences with over 800 delegates attending.

"We are showcasing the broadcasting technology that is spreading through Europe like wildfire to the relevant people in the industry," said Robert-jan van der Hoeven. He is CEO of Broadcast Partners.
