SwissMediaCast launches Two New Regional Digital Radio Networks using DAB⁺ Head-end equipment from VDL

1st January 2014 saw the launch of two new digital radio networks in the Berne/Freiburg area and in eastern Switzerland by SwissMediaCast AG (Wangen SZ, Switzerland).

SwissMediaCast selected VDL (Lyon, France) and Sumatronic AG (Unterägeri, Switzerland) to supply DAB⁺ Encoding, Multiplexing Head-end systems, plus installation and support services. The selection was made following extensive commercial and technical evaluations.

The two new transmission networks are the second phase in the roll-out a total of 5 regional DAB⁺ networks for the 3rd DAB-Layer in the German-speaking part of Switzerland, with the remaining two networks planned for launch in 2015/2016. The first network was launched on 1st December 2012, covering the Zurich, Aargau and Schaffhausen areas.

VDL's Swiss partner, Sumatronic AG, played a major role in SwissMediaCast's decision to use VDL Headend equipment, due to their extensive broadcast systems experience, technical competence and local support capabilities.

The VDL DAB⁺ Multiplexers are located at the SwissMediaCast Playout Centre in Zurich, alongside the existing VDL DAB⁺ Multiplexers of the first phase DAB⁺ networks. DAB⁺ Audio Encoders are located at the radio stations studios and connected to the Playout Centre via dedicated IP networks.

Hans Strassmann, CTO of SwissMediaCast commented: "VDL was able to provide excellent international references, while Sumatronic has the experience and capability to provide the best possible service to SwissMediaCast. So, we have both a technically advanced and very cost-effective solution for our customers and our Company. By 2016, five regional DAB⁺ networks in the entire German-speaking area of Switzerland will be on-air."



Since October 2009, SwissMediaCast (SMC) has operated the second DAB+ Layer in the German speaking area of Switzerland. In April 2012, Switzerland's Federal Office of Communications (Bakom) awarded SwissMediaCast (SMC) a second radio licence to operate an additional digital DAB⁺ transmitter network with regional allotments.

The network consists of five coverage areas in German-speaking Switzerland and enables the radio stations to target their programme services at a regional audience. Furthermore, the SRG SSR are able to transmit its regional news programmes in digital form.

SMC launched the first regional network in the Zurich-Aargau-Schaffhausen area in December 2012 and now the two regional networks in the Berne/Freiburg area and in eastern Switzerland in January 2014. Programmes on the new DAB⁺ network will be available across the whole of German-speaking Switzerland in the next few years.

Sales of DAB⁺ radio receivers in Switzerland are increasing and have reached 1.2 million, with approximately one third of all Swiss homes able to receive DAB⁺ programmes.
