Digital Audio Broadcasting (DAB) is the digital radio broadcasting standard used in the Czech Republic where listeners can enjoy over 30 services. DAB is the chosen digital radio standard used in several countries across Europe and Asia Pacific. There are currently 1,950 DAB and DAB+ services on air worldwide and over 46 million DAB/DAB+ services have been sold globally so far.

RTI cz Ltd (radio tele investment) has operated on the Czech market since 1998, mainly focusing on radio and TV signal propagation.
They currently operate several dozen radio transmitters for FM broadcasting mainly in West Bohemia and DAB transmitters in the Prague, Pilsen, South



Bohemia and Karlovy regions.
